Philosophy and Process Highlights

Under our intrinsic value philosophy, we:

- Treat every investment as a partial ownership interest in that company
- Seek to invest at a discount to intrinsic value
- Possess a long-term investment temperament
- Recognize that market price and intrinsic value tend to converge over a reasonable period of time

Portfolio Guidelines

- Typically 50-80 positions
- Maximum position size is 7%
- Top 10 holdings are typically greater than 25% of net assets
- Maximum industry exposure is 20%
- Maximum sector exposure is 30%


Market Capitalization

The portfolio typically invests in companies with a market capitalization below \$3 billion (or, if greater, the maximum market capitalization of companies generally within the capitalization range of the Russell 2000 Index) at the time of purchase.


